Building Work

It was hoped that the building work would have commenced before the end of term but this has been delayed until January. This will provide one new classroom next to Mr Bannister's Class. The second part of the work will move the main entrance to school to what is currently the back entrance. This will mean that visitors will no longer have to cross the playground to gain access when school is in operation. The work will be completed by September 2021.
