Chair:

Another cheque for £4,000 will be presented to the school. Mandy Harris confirmed it will go towards purchasing books for the new library area. The remainder will stay in the account to be used for expenditure on the forthcoming events.

Debbie confirmed that the PTA accounts will be audited by Mr Shilling after the AGM meeting.

Mandy Harris conveyed her thanks by staff and teachers for raising funds towards resources for the School.

Headteacher:

Nina Chwastek conveyed her thanks to all for running the events, it was a massive year and an enormous success in terms of money raised and community involvement. Particularly considering the difficult events surrounding the fraud case, everyone still supported the PTA.

Money that has been recouped from the fraud case has gone directly to the school and the children i.e. the new library area.

The impact of what the school has raised for the school:

- 2015/16 outdoor area early years
- 2016/17 books across the school
- 2017/18 outdoor area of the main playground

Portacabins have now gone. The land belongs to the parish but Father John is happy to share its use. The school and parish are working together to explore how it can be used by both parties.

PTA agreed with the schools wish to update the main playground and the fundraising target has been set at £18,000.
